

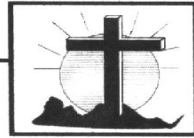

Dear Parents,

Hello! God bless you!

Thank you for considering New Hope Christian Academy (NHCA) for your child/children. One of our goals is to make your decision (to send your child to NHCA) one of the best decisions you will ever make.

NHCA is a private school exempt from licensing by the Private Elementary and Secondary Education Authorization Act. This school belongs to the Lord Jesus Christ and is open to members of the body of Christ.

Sending your child to NHCA is a commitment. It should be given deliberate thought and careful consideration. Your time and resources will be required in order to make this program what it is intended to be. We encourage your participation and input, so that we will all be blessed as we join efforts to provide the safest and best educational environment possible.

Enrollment Requirements:

1. **Please read over the whole packet before submitting the application.** All forms must be completed and signed. The Fellowship Commitment Form and Student Record Release Form are not stapled together with the other forms. Included with the enrollment forms are the NHCA Handbook and Discipline Policy Manual.

By applying to NHCA, you are making a commitment to uphold the policies of NHCA.

2. Submit the completed application with the registration fee: \$200 – all grades. Application **must include** a copy of the birth certificate and social security number, and immunization record.

Prior to the interview, the following must be accomplished:

- A copy of the student's transcripts or last report card **MUST** be turned in with the application.
- The Discipline Policy Manual and NHCA Handbook should be read, understood, and signed by the parents and the student.
- The student must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher to be accepted in the New Hope Christian Academy curriculum. Only members of New Hope Fellowship may have an exemption from this requirement. Please ask in the church office for details.

-It is **required** that the parents and those children below 7th grade, who will be attending NHCA, be involved and committed to a Bible believing church. Those young people from 7th grade to 12th grade maybe exempt from this requirement of including the parents in attendance. **HOWEVER**, the student must be in regular attendance at a Bible believing church AND/OR regularly attend a Church Youth Group at a local Bible believing church.

Regular attendance is defined as attendance of at least 3 services per month, active within the church and regular giving of tithes to that church.

Those families just moving into the area and are not in regular attendance (as defined above) will be required to start regular attendance at New Hope Fellowship with the 7th-12th grade student (if applicable) in attendance at NHF youth group until a suitable church family is found.

-A student may be accepted on a provisional status (accepted with one or more of the above requirements waived) for the first ninety (90) days. **HOWEVER**, if during that time, either the parents or New Hope Christian Academy believe the student should be dismissed, there will be no reimbursement from monies paid or uniforms bought.

3. NHCA **will then schedule** an interview. At least one (but preferably both) parents **must** accompany the student to the interview. **The interview IS REQUIRED for acceptance.**
4. The Registration fee and the first tuition payment will be due at the interview. The Student/Parent Consent Form from the Discipline Policy Manual must be turned in at the interview also.
5. The student will need school uniforms. These are purchased from Campus Club (see attached flyer). Students starting school after school has begun will have 2 weeks to purchase uniforms.

"I further understand that discontinuance of church involvement and/or attendance is grounds for dismissal from New Hope Christian Academy."

1. **The tuition amount is the cost to place your child(ren) at NHCA. All budgeting for the school year is based on the commitment of the family to pay the tuition amount. New Hope Christian Academy ALLOWS that tuition to be paid in installments as indicated in (2) below. If a Student is withdrawn anytime during the school year, the tuition amount is due in full.**
2. We commit to pay tuition according to the following arrangements, and to make all required payments. Our payment preference is (check one of the following):
 - ___ **Payment in full**
 - ___ **Payment by semester** (August 1st and January 1st)
 - ___ **Payment in 10 monthly installments**, payable on the 1st of each month, August through May.

3. If the student is dismissed from school for any disciplinary reasons (suspension, expulsion), NHCA will not offer nor give a refund of any monies paid.
4. If payment of tuition is on the monthly schedule, then payment is due for the month no matter how many days the student is in class.
5. **I/We agree that if our child/children is/are left after 3:00p.m. that a charge of \$25 will be assessed plus \$10.00 per hour (or any portion of an hour). Exceptions will be for sports and special field trips.**
6. When an account becomes seven (7) days past due a late charge of \$15.00 will be assessed to that account. If the account becomes fifteen (15) days past due an additional \$10 charge will be accessed (making total late fee \$25.00)
7. We understand that a \$25.00 check returned fee may be assessed to the account for any returned checks.
8. We agree to pay the balance of our account before requesting transcripts to be released.
9. I understand that if I allow my debt to become more than thirty (30) days past due, I am subjecting my child/children to the possibility of dismissal from New Hope Christian Academy.
10. Tuition and fees for the previous year must be paid in full before students can begin the current year.
11. We agree to the policies outlined in the NHCA Handbook, Discipline Manual, and Uniform code.

***Normal tuition payments begin in August and end May.**

Important Note: Tuition "monthly payments" are not a monthly fee for school time, but an easier and less burdensome way to make the total payment. Payments may be made:

- 1. one lump sum (Yearly Payment)**
- 2. two equal payments (the first ½ of tuition on 1st of August, the second on 1st of January.**
- 3. 10 equal payments (Paid Monthly); Payments are due each month August – May.**

The first student for discount purposes is always the highest ranking (grade) student being enrolled.

Some extra-curricular activities may require extra funds. These will be collected at the time of the event.

NHCA is not for profit, but exists as a ministry of New Hope Fellowship. NHCA will not be in the debt collection business, as we intend to spend our time and energy educating children. This agreement is more than just a "contract" between two parties. This is a covenant between members of the family of God, before God. NOT fulfilling your obligation is between you and God. It is therefore our desire that you honor your commitments, and "let your yes, be yes..."

Any suggestions, complaints or requests concerning tuition payments should be directed to the NHCA Administrator or Pastor.

Students enrolling anytime during the 1st semester will pay full tuition, during the second semester an amount equal to ½ of the full years tuition will be due.

No new enrollments for the current school year will be taken after the end of the 3rd nine week period.
